- Two rounds of golf for 2. One each at Lancaster Country Club & Bent Creek Country Club.

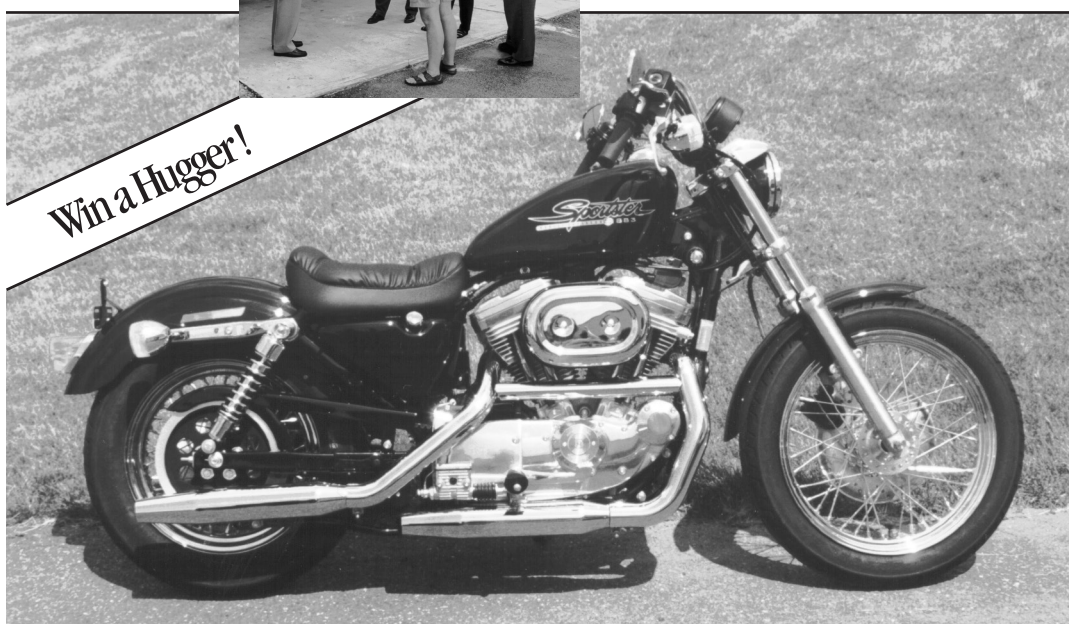
The Harley-Davidson is a dark blue 1998 Huggler 883 with staggered dual shorty exhaust pipes, peanut tank, and chrome spokes.

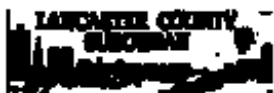

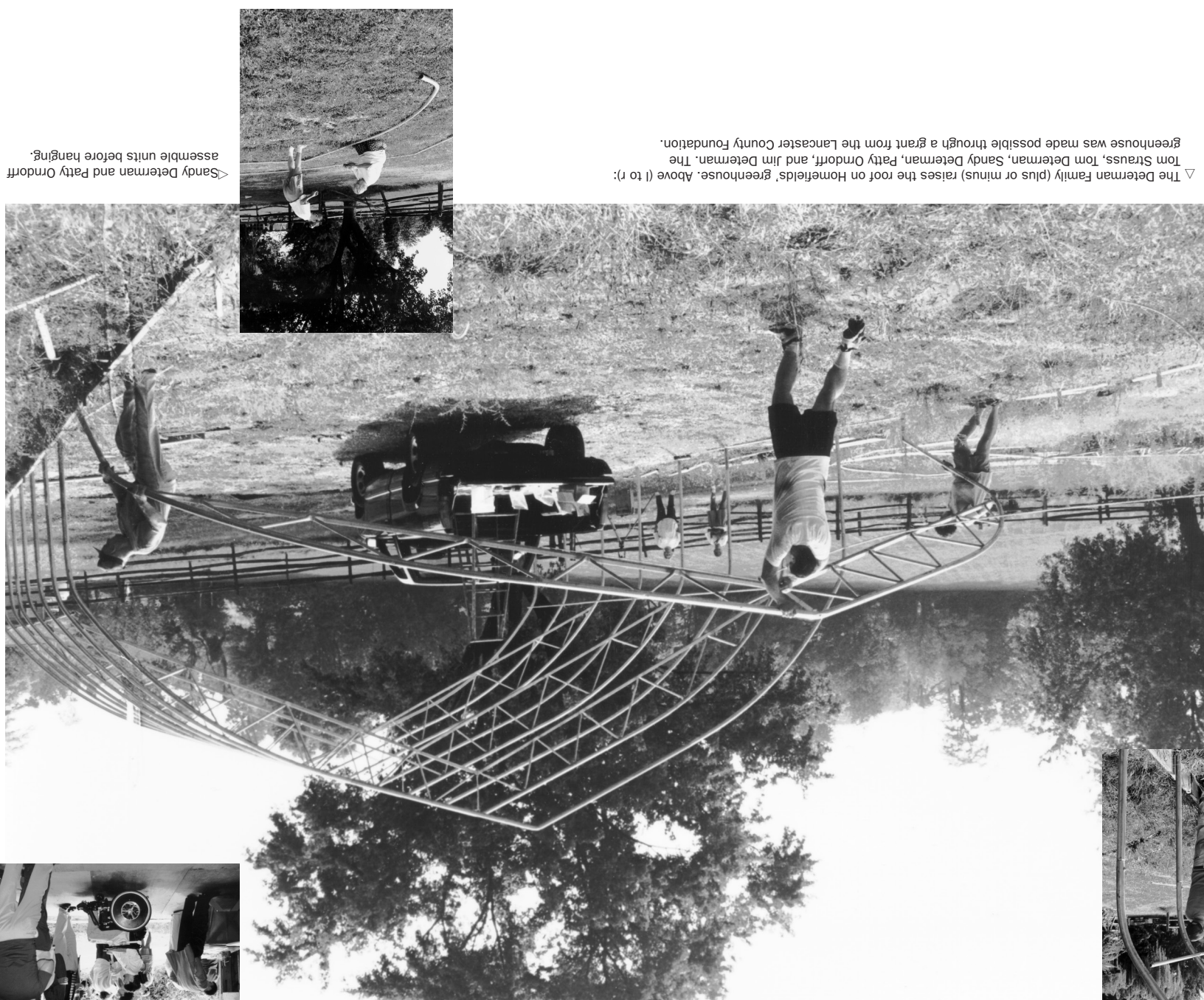
